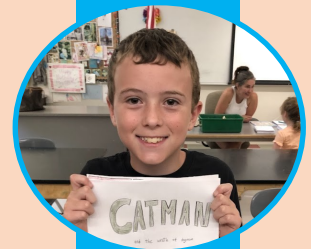

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Summer Camp FAQs

What is your refund policy?

Playground Camps: The last day to cancel and receive a refund is June 1. After June 1st, if you need to cancel your child's registration, we can offer you a refund **IF** we are able to fill your child's spot in the camp with someone that is on the waitlist.

Specialty Camps: One week's notice is required for all cancellation requests. If it is within one week of the camp start date, we can only offer you a refund if we are able to fill your child's spot in the camp.

If my Playground Camp is sold out on a given week, can I register my child for one of the other Playground Camp sites if there are spots available in that site?

Yes; if your preferred campsite is sold out on a given week, you can sign your child up at a different campsite instead. We suggest that you also add your child's name to the waitlist at your preferred campsite in the event that a spot opens up.

Last Summer, I registered online for one of your camps, and when I went to pay, I received an error message saying that the camp was now full. How do I avoid that this Summer?

This was a common problem last Summer. In our software system (RecDesk), your spot in a given program or camp is not reserved until **AFTER** you've completed all the required documents and submitted payment.

There are several strategies you can employ to speed up the registration process so you don't lose your spot:

- Fill out the Youth Registration Form for your child(ren) in advance of April 1st. You only need to fill out this form once for each child. To fill out this form, go to our website, go to *Programs*, in the search bar, search Youth Registration Form, select *Register*, and follow the prompts. There is no cost to fill out the form early.
- Determine which camps you'd like to register for in advance of April 1st & 8th.
- Bus transportation (from Specialty Camp to Playground Camp) is listed as a program in RecDesk this Summer. This "program" won't sell out, so register for it **AFTER** you've registered for all of your desired camps.
- Have your credit card with you when you begin the registration process or save your credit card information on your computer/phone.

I did not get my child into the Specialty Camp that he/she wants; Can I change my Playground Camp registration from half-day to full-day for that week?

Yes! You can change from half-day to full-day (or vice versa) anytime. Please email Josh @ jwolff@eastgreenwichri.com to process the change.

Do you offer Scholarships?

Yes, scholarships are available for our Playground Camps for families that are signed up for the School Department's free or reduced lunch program. Please visit our website or stop by the Rec Office to pick up a Scholarship Application. Please note: the maximum amount awarded is \$350 per child per year.
